## AAC Members Novelty Show “WINTER” 2012 “WINTER”

The pieces can be any size and in any medium as long as they relate to the theme “WINTER”.

*No volunteer hours are required to enter, however your art must have been through the normal “Juried in’ process to hang in the Gallery*

There are two parts to this show. Some of our art will be hung in the two dining rooms at the Multicultural Centre in Stony Plain and some will be hung here in the Program Room, in the Melcor Cultural Centre. They will need a short bio of each artist and a short history of the Allied Arts Council to post along with the art. Please include a bio along with your submission.

We need your application form into the gallery by ***January 11<sup>th</sup>***, so that the list can be typed up for the Curator of the Multicultural Centre to come and make the selections for that venue. He will need around 20 pieces.

The actual pieces are to be delivered to the Program Room on Saturday, January 14<sup>th</sup> between 1 pm and 4 pm. [Similar to the Juried Members Show process]. The Multicultural Selections will be made on January 16<sup>th</sup> and then you are to come and retrieve the rest of the art on January 16<sup>th</sup> between 3 pm and 8 pm, and bring it back on January 28<sup>th</sup> to be hung in the Program Room on January 30, 2012, until March 3, 2012.

The art in the Multicultural Centre will be hung by their staff and then on February 15, 2012 it will be taken down, and returned to the Spruce Grove Art Gallery. The process for retrieving this art is still to be worked out, so check with Steve Nagy, Exhibition Chair, as the time draws near.
